

2025 Summer Spotlights

Summer Spotlights are camps designed for children from all schools looking for a fun and exciting way to take away summer boredom!

Registration ends two weeks prior to the first day of each camp to allow instructors plenty of time to prepare for registered students.

Make sure the camp(s) you choose are age appropriate for your child.

Campers must be in good health and able to participate in all activities listed in the enrolled camp. The required medication must be administered at home before arriving for camp session. Any exceptions will require guardian consent and a written doctor's order to be on file with medication and a written care plan for children with asthma or severe allergies. Each day, campers must be fever free and have no symptoms of illness including allergies.

Space is limited!

- Instructors have a minimum/maximum number of allowed campers.
- Camps will be filled on a first come, first served basis.
- A waiting list will be available if a camp is full.
- Registration for each camp will close 2 weeks prior to camp, email <u>mturman@facsmemphis.org</u> for verification.
- FACS does not offer online registration for the Summer Spotlight Camps.
- Registration forms must be completed, signed, and returned with a \$30 non-refundable registration fee, plus full payment -or- required deposit for each chosen camp to complete the registration process.
- Each camp deposit reserves your spot and is non-refundable/non-transferable unless the camp is cancelled. Remaining payment is due on the first day of camp.

- Make payments to FACS with cash, check, or money order. (Returned check fee is \$45)
